plus 3 WINS in Playoffs, including Super Bowl #7 WIN, versus "Washington," score 14-7

2007 "New England Patriots," achieved 16-0 WL Record (Regular Season)...
however, "New England" LOST in Super Bowl #42, versus "New York Giants," score 17-14

## Lowest WL Record To Win Super Bowl:

2011 "New York Giants," achieved 9-7 WL Record (Regular Season)...
plus 4 WINS in Playoffs, including Super Bowl \#46 WIN, versus "New England," score 21-17

## Lowest WL Record To Never Miss Playoffs:

The 12-4 WL Record always guarantees "Qualifying" for the Playoffs.
Fact: the 12-4 WL Record has WON "12" Super Bowl Titles (the "Most Titles" by any WL Record). Noteworthy: the 10-6 WL Record Playoff Teams have "NEVER LOST" in the Super Bowl Final.
Note: but, the 10-6 WL Record Playoff Teams, have only WON "4" Super Bowls, in 55 years.

## Highest WL Record To Miss the Playoffs:

Because of losing "Playoff Ties" versus "11-5 Miami Dolphins" \& "11-5 Baltimore Ravens" The 1985 "Denver Broncos," achieved 11-5 WL Record (Regular Season), but missed Playoffs. Why? Because of losing "Playoff Ties" versus "11-5 New York Jets" \& "11-5 New England Patriots"

## Lowest WL Record Ever To Qualify For The Playoffs:

The 2020 "Washington Football Team," achieved only a 7-9 WL Record (Regular Season).
The 2010 "Seattle Seahawks," achieved only a 7-9 WL Record (Regular Season).
Note: both of these 7-9 WL Teams, WON their respective DIVISIONS, in those specified years.
